Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for taking the time to complete our parent survey. Your feedback is incredibly valuable celebrating what you feel we do well and helping us continue to improve Blossomfield for all our children.

100% of parents who responded would recommend Blossomfield to another parent and 100% felt that the school makes them aware of what their child will learn during the year.

The other statements with the highest percentage at strongly agree and agree (90% or more) were:

My child is happy at Blossomfield.

My child feels safe at Blossomfield.

Blossomfield makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.

My child does well at Blossomfield.

Blossomfield lets me know how my child is doing.

There is a good range of subjects available to my child at Blossomfield.

My child can take part in clubs and activities at Blossomfield.

We were pleased to hear so many of your positive comments:

- **Blossomfield staff:** You said that our staff are professional, friendly, patient and dedicated. "Every member of staff seems always keen to support. Greetings on the gate are a lovely touch. So lovely to see the Headteacher and Deputy involved in the children's day"
- **Communication:** "Communication to parents is wonderful- I feel I know what my child will be learning throughout the year from the Curriculum overviews and the weekly newsletters are so informative." "They consistently kept me informed and most importantly ensured my child felt safe, happy and supported."
- **Celebrating Achievements:** "The school really support and celebrate the wider child, awards from home, writing activities, which encourages children to do more."
- **Working Together:** "Parent workshops are really appreciated and is such a lovely and special time given to parents to work with their child." "Conversations at parents evenings are really supportive and parents are really listened to and considered."

We appreciate your comments about areas we can improve. They Included:

- **Further Developing capacity to support children with Special Needs:** Vulnerable learners are quickly identified at Blossomfield and staff work with parents and relevant agencies to try to ensure bespoke provision is in place to best support their needs. The provision has changed in response to the complexity of need and we are developing the following:

- A range of interventions offered throughout school and their effectiveness evaluated.
E.g. ELS phonics intervention, Writing and Maths Clubs.
- Creating learning environments within which all children can thrive.
- Adaptive whole class teaching and for children with high needs a personalised curriculum
- The family room is a provision for children who need access to a break out space for their learning, and whose learning may look very different from their year group.
- Ash classroom with outdoor space may be used as an additional place for children who need short interventions creating an enabling learning space for them to work with staff.
